Storytelling Game Instructions

Welcome! First print and cut out the cards.

Gameplay: Use your imagination and these cards to create amazing adventures and tales.

Mode 1: My Own Story (Easier)

1. Shuffle the Cards: Mix all the cards and put them in a pile, face down.
2. Pick Your Cards: Each player picks 8 random cards. (Start with 3 for smaller children)
3. Make a Story: Look at the pictures on your cards. Use all your cards to make up your own story.
4. Share Your Story: Tell your story to everyone, using the cards in the order you want.
5. Everyone Takes a Turn: After one person finishes, the next player tells their story.

Mode 2: Our Story Together (More Difficult)

1. Shuffle the Cards: Mix all the cards and put them in a pile, face down.
2. Start the Story: The first player picks a card from the pile and starts the story.
3. Add to the Story: The next player picks a card and adds to the story. Keep taking turns, each person adding to the story using the card they pick.
4. Decide when to stop: Continue until:
 - a. 10 cards are used
 - b. all the cards are used
 - c. a specific card is drawn
 - d. or you decide to end the story.

Tips

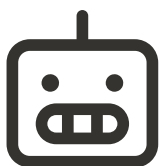
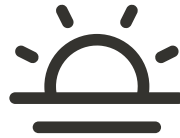
- For **Toddlers**: Let them pick a card and describe what they see. Ask simple questions like, "What sound does this animal make?"
- For **Preschoolers**: Guide them in making simple three-part stories (beginning, middle, end).
- For **Older Kids**: Challenge them to add unexpected twists or turn it into a challenge—who can make the most exciting, funny, or mysterious tale?
- Be Creative: Use your imagination to make the story **fun and exciting**.
- Have Fun: The most important part is to **enjoy** telling and listening to the stories.

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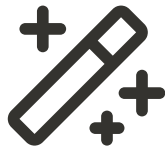
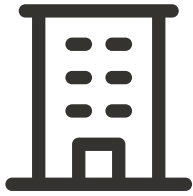
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Print on A4 paper and cut out the cards.



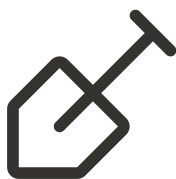
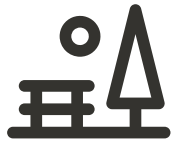
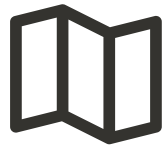
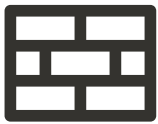
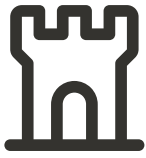


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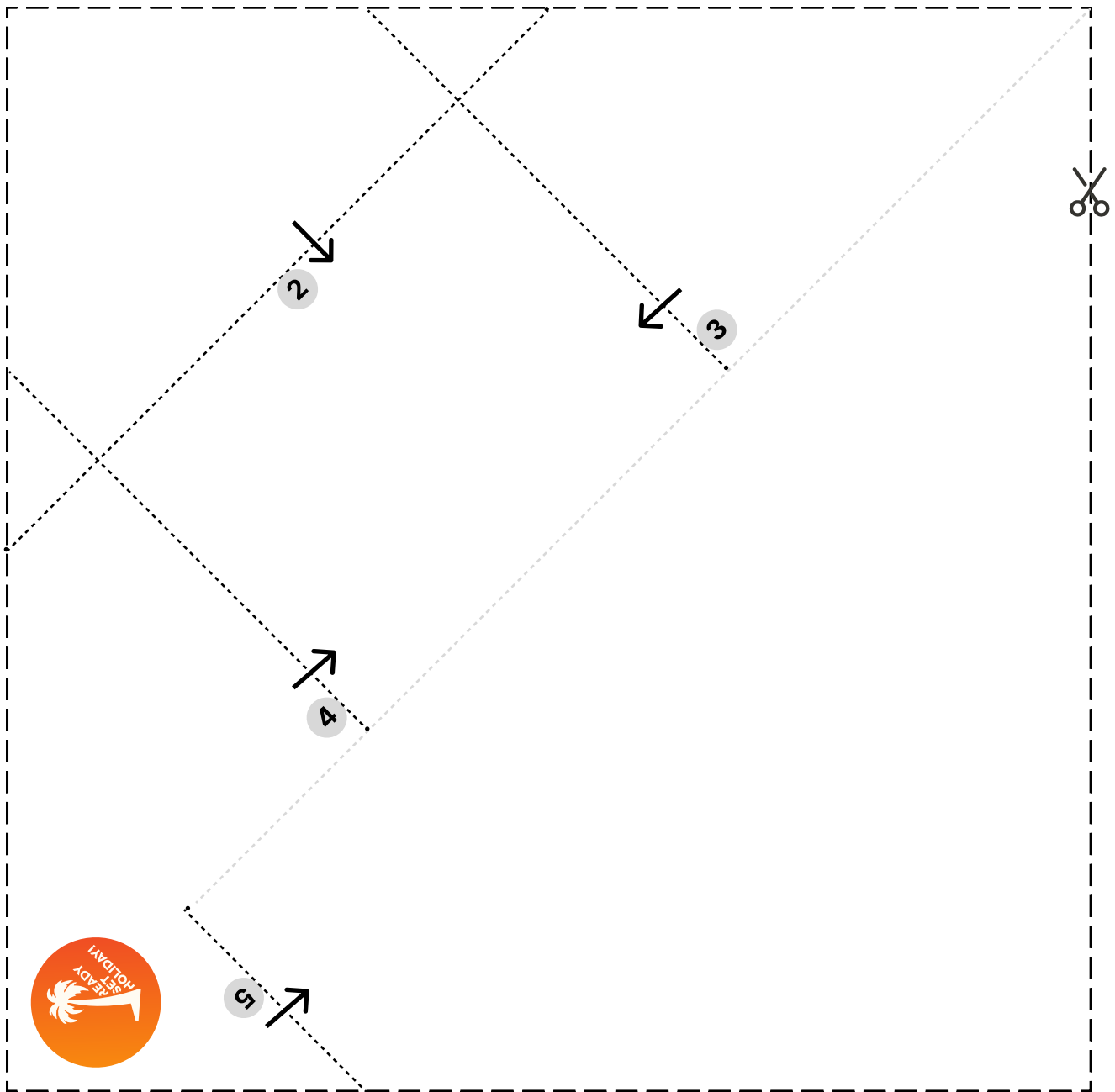


Print on A4 paper and cut out the cards.





Print on A4, cut out and fold the envelope.



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Origami Envelope (No glue required)

1. Carefully cut out the square on the dashed line and fold in half on the grey diagonal line, so the numbers are visible. Hold it corner pointing up, so you can still see numbers 2,3 and 4.
2. Fold one tip down along dotted line number 2.
3. Fold right corner in, on the dotted line 3 (a third, see image).
4. Fold left corner in, on the dotted line 4 (another third), to create an envelope shape.
5. Fold the tip back towards left, on the dotted line 5, the fold should be aligned with the middle of the envelope.
6. Open that tip to form a square shape and press down. Now fold the "lid" down until it fits well inside the small square.
